Where the Wild Things Are June 15th and 17th

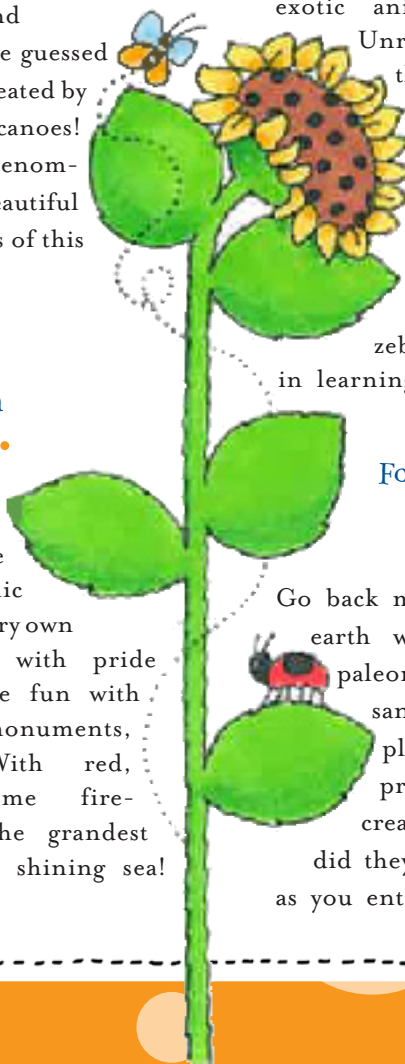
