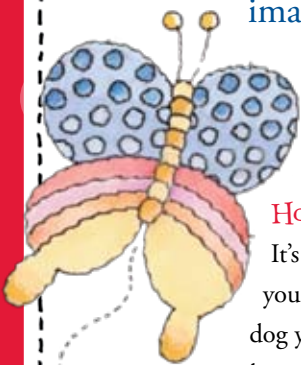

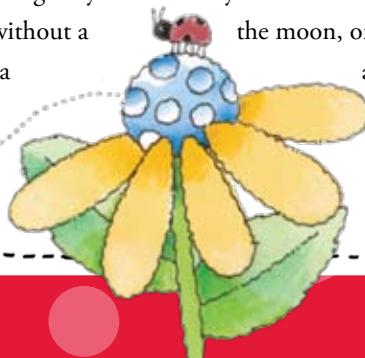
## It's a Small, Small World (June 23 and 25)
